I. Call to order

- d) President: Reed Brown
 - The NWCC bookkeeper will retire at the end of 2011. Residential Community Management has been recommended and is used by several other area neighborhoods. A motion was made and seconded to enter into a contract with Residential Community Management. The motion passed.
 - Letters were sent to all homeonwers that owe \$800 or more in unpaid dues.
 - The State of Texas passed new laws that conflict with NWCC deed restrictions.
 - NWCC web site is dormant.
 - Kirkwood reconstruction from I-10 to Memorial will begin summer 2012 and last for 18 months.

V. Committee Reports

- e) Constable Report: Sergeant Bauer
 - Sgt Bauer recommended that with the holidays approaching, residents should not leave outgoing mail or UPS packages on their front porch.
 - Residents with burglar alarms should have alarm company contact Precinct 5 Constable instead of Houston Police Department.
- f) Architectural Control Committee: Preston Mood
 - Nineteen new home plans have been approved. No new plans submitted.
 - Lawns look bad due to the extended drought. No pressure on homeowners to keep lawns watered only on keeping lawns neat.
 - Fourteen lots have dead trees that need to be removed. Letters will go out to homeowners.
