## Nottingham West 2013 Budget and Assessment

The Nottingham West Civic Club officers and board of directors have reviewed the proposed NWCC budget for 2013 and the Revenue & Expense summary is included on page 4. Our deed restrictions allow for an assessment increase equal to the Consumer Price Index without a homeowner vote. Due to increased maintenance costs, the officers and board have approved an assessment increase for 2013 of \$8 per household, based on the CPI of 1.4% as of July 31, 2012.

The current annual dues are \$600 per household and will increase to \$608 effective January 1. Homeowners will receive a separate statement mailed directly from RealManage for January dues of \$304. Assessments are due by January 31 and may be paid online through the RealManage web site (See details on page 2).

The cost to maintain our neighborhood as a desirable place for families to live continues to increase. At the January meeting, we will discuss a proposed increase to homeowner dues of 6% to 7.5%, beginning in July 2013. This will create a reserve fund to cover unexpected expenses.

Please review the budget information and attend the annual meeting on January 16. This is **your** neighborhood and needs **your** help and input to keep it a subdivision of choice in West Houston.

#### Nottingham West Civic Club Meeting Minutes October 17, 2012

- 1) Meeting called to order at 7:33 with 27 households represented.
- 2) Agenda adopted
- 3) Minutes reviewed and approved as printed
- 4) Constables Report: One incident since August 1
  - a) One theft call, but no report filed.
  - b) One abandoned vehicle
- 5) Officer's Reports
  - a) Secretary Angie Lootens

- 6) Committee Reports
  - a) Architectural Control
    - i) There are 22 new homes approved for construction; nineteen have already been completed.
    - ii) Homeowners that experience problems with builders should contact Preston Mood at 281-543-7994.
    - iii) A homeowner reported a problem with city workers on Kirkwood. The best way to address these problems is to call 3-1-1, or visit the City of Houston web site (<a href="www.houstontx.gov">www.houstontx.gov</a>). Be sure to get a case number.
- 7) New Business
  - a) John Benton presented details about the proposed upgrade for the Nottingham West Playground and Park. This vote was to determine if the neighborhood supports improvements to the park. A future discussion and vote will be held to determine specific upgrades and costs. Motion made and seconded to vote on the plan.
  - b) The upgrade was approved. Sixty four homeowners voted with 36 in favor and 28 opposed. Thirty-seven votes were cast by e-mail/mail.
