



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

NOTTINGHAM WEST CIVIC CLUB, INC.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, all being residents and citizens of the State of Texas, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST

The name of the corporation is:

NOTTINGHAM WEST CIVIC CLUB, INC.

SECOND

The corporation is and shall be a non-profit corporation. No dividend shall be paid by the corporation and no part of the income of the corporation shall be distributed to its officers or directors. Provided, however, that officers or directors may be paid reasonable compensation for services actually rendered.

THIRD

The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual unless dissolved by operation of law, or by voluntary action of its Board of Directors in the manner provided by law.

FOURTH

The corporation is organized for purely benevolent and civic purposes, and the purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

To promote and encourage civic pride, and to promote health, sanitation, safety, and convenience of Nottingham West and the adjacent community, in Harris County, Texas, and by way of illustration, and not by way of limitation, to accomplish such purposes by performing or assisting in the performance, or procuring, or assisting in the procuring, or by subsidizing of any or all of the following:

- Lighting, improving, planting, landscaping, beautifying and maintaining streets, parks, parkways and esplanades;
- bus service, police patrol service, watchman services;
- collecting and disposing of garbage, ashes, trash and

refuse; protection of the community against unlawful use of property and against violation of public and private regulations restricting or affecting use thereof; subsidizing or providing for establishment, operation, maintenance and equipment of wholesome community recreational facilities; performance of any other services necessary or desirable to keep the community neat or in good order.

FIFTH

The incorporators shall constitute the initial membership of the corporation. Additional members may be admitted upon such terms and conditions, and upon meeting such qualifications, as may be prescribed by the corporation. The corporation, by its by-laws, may provide for associate members, who shall be admitted upon such terms and conditions, and upon meeting such qualifications, as may be prescribed by the corporation and its by-laws. Associate members shall have no vote on any matter submitted to a vote of the members of the corporation.

SIXTH

The corporation is not a church.

SEVENTH

The number of directors of the corporation shall be three. The number of directors may not be changed except by amendment of the Articles of Incorporation. No decrease in numbers shall have the effect of shortening the term of any incumbent director. The term of office of each of the directors constituting the first Board of Directors shall be nine years each, and their terms of office shall expire January 1, 1974. Thereafter, the term of office of a director shall be three years.

EIGHTH

The street address of the initial registered office is 5702 Griggs Road, Houston, Texas, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Perrin W. White.

NINTH

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is three, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as members of said initial Board of Directors are:
